

ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

Pre-registering your interest via our website will help us connect with you and provide you with the next steps required to check your eligibility.

To be eligible for Professional Internship program, you must meet the following minimum requirements:

Be over 18 years of age.



IELTS of 6.0 + OR a PTE score of 50+ OR enrolled in an ELSIS course at ECA* OR have completed year 12 studies with English as the language of instruction.



You're an Australian/ NZ Citizen or Permanent Resident OR able to obtain a suitable visa with work rights.Student visa holders (subclass 500) are also eligible.

Either enrolled or have completed an Advanced Diploma OR have an equivalent qualification of AQF 6 or above.



Be available for a minimum 2 days a week for a placement of 10 to 12 weeks. The work hours are approximately 10-20 hours each week.

Other factors such as
Universal Cognitive Aptitude
Test scores are also used
as part of the evaluation
process. ECA Internships'
decision on eligibility and
acceptance is final and
binding.

*ELSIS - General English - Level 5 upper intermediate and above or Cambridge FCE (First Certificate in English), CAE (Advanced English).



Program fees

Internship fees will depend on your choice of program. Fees are inclusive of all program costs as well as the cost of Workers Insurance for the full period of your internship.

Enrolment Fee

This is payable once you receive and accept an offer.

Placement Fee

This is payable once the placement has been confirmed and accepted.

Your final fee will be determined once you complete your registration process. At this stage, you are not obliged to pay anything or proceed with an internship. The purpose of the registration process is simply to determine your eligibility and to provide you with information regarding the program.




INTERNSHIP JOURNEY
