- This scholarship offer is from 20% up to 25% off tuition fees for the courses offered at VU Sydney
- ONSHORE: non-refundable AUD \$2,500 deposit for the CoE.
- The scholarship is available to all (onshore and offshore) students commencing study at VU Sydney from May 2020 intake onwards, up to November 2020. Scholarships cannot be issued to students who have commenced prior to May 2020.
- The scholarship is available to all students who meet the programs' entry requirements.
- The scholarship will be applied when student has confirmed an 8-unit enrolment for the academic year 2020, or if less than 8 units are required then the total number of units required for completion.
- The scholarship will be made automatically available for students who enrol in a full-time study load for the academic year 2020.
- The credit will be made available prior to each of the following study periods.
- The credit for a subsequent period of study will be made available via invoice issuance for each study period
- If a student withdraws from a subsequent period of study, the scholarship is null and void.
- The credit from the scholarship can be used for tuition fees only – it is not transferrable or made available in cash.
- Spaces are limited and available on first come first served basis
- This scholarship cannot be taken in conjunction with any other scholarship or bursary awarded by VU Sydney;
- The scholarship offer is liable to change per VU Sydney's discretion and the decision of VU Sydney is final
- Tuition fees are subject to an annual increase each calendar year.
- Students will be able to pay per subject enrolled via *Easypay*.
- Deposit is non-refundable.

#### \*Terms and conditions:

- Onshore applicants Diploma of IT holders applying for RPL / Advanced Standing, and receiving less than 8 Units' credits towards the NBIT Bachelor of Information Technology, will automatically receive scholarship to cover the units of studies to a maximum of 2 units.
- Advanced Diploma of IT holders, receiving less than 10 units towards the NBIT Bachelor of Information Technology, will also automatically receive scholarship to cover the units of studies to a maximum of 2 units.
- Students are automatically assessed after submitting their application for an eligible qualification
- The scholarship will only be assessed for once the new student has registered and paid in full for the First Instalment.
- The scholarship arrangement is a non-transferable and cannot be used in conjunction with any other student scholarship program running within VU Sydney or any other purpose
- Scholarship will be granted once. If the student fails the unit, they are required to pay full tuition when they attempt to re-do the subject.
- Scholarship to be applied in the second semester of studies or as per availability of the unit offer given as scholarship.
- Scholarship will only be applied if student has paid fees for commencing semester in full, and on time. Fees for commencing.
- semester must be paid by any agreed fee extension due date in order for students to be awarded the scholarship.
- For the purpose of the scholarship, ONLY tuition fees will be covered
- The scholarship does not include all other expenses such as incidental fees which vary across the courses, books, accommodation, OSHC among others. There is no cash or refund of fees issued to students.
- All tuition fees are subject to an annual increase each year of study, effective at the start of each calendar year.
- This increase will be reflected in invoicing issued to the student
- This annual increase in fees is covered as part of the agreed terms and conditions of the student's Letter of Offer.
- Exemptions of up to 10 units for some providers and scholarships for up to 2 units
- The IT Career Launcher Scholarship is only available to students commencing from 2020
- The conditions of the offer are subject to change on the discretion of VU Sydney and the decision of VU Sydney is final.

## 2021 VU Future Leaders Scholarship (International)

### About the Scholarship

The VU Future Leaders Scholarship (International) supports new international students who plan to commence their undergraduate or postgraduate (coursework) studies in January to October 2021.

- How to apply: Students will be required to confirm that they wish to be considered for the scholarship at the time they submit their application for admission into an eligible VU qualification. Scholarship eligibility can only be assessed after the applicant has met the course entry requirements.
- Value (2021 commencement): 20% off the first two semesters' tuition fee. Upon successful completion of two semesters, students will be assessed for an extension of the scholarship based on academic performance. This is valued at 10% off the tuition fee per semester for the remainder of their studies.
- Eligibility (2021 commencement): All new students commencing an undergraduate or postgraduate (coursework) course with VU in January to October are eligible (please refer to terms and conditions below).

### \*Terms and conditions:

- Students must pay the required tuition fee deposit to accept their offer. The remaining balance is due before the course start date.
- Students who have received a scholarship or sponsorship from another organisation are not eligible for this scholarship.
- Current VU students changing from one course to another with advanced standing (credits) are not eligible for this scholarship.
- After two semesters of study, students may be eligible for an extension of this scholarship. The extension is valued at 10% of the semester's tuition fee for the remainder of their studies. Students must maintain a 60 course Weighted Average Mark (WAM).
- Students with approval to reduce their study load are eligible to receive a reduced scholarship, based on the number of units taken (pro-rata).
- New students receiving advanced standing for previous studies are not eligible for the extension of the VU Future Leaders Scholarship (International).
- The VU Future Leaders Scholarship (International) is not refundable, convertible to cash, or transferable to another individual, commencing study period, or course.
- The VU Future Leaders Scholarship (International) is awarded at the discretion of the University.
- The student will continue to remain eligible to receive the VU Future Leaders Scholarship (International) and the extension of the scholarship providing the student pays all tuition and additional fees/costs in full by census date each study period and meets the conditions of their student visa.
- Victoria University may make changes to these terms and conditions without notice.
- The University's decision concerning the assessment of eligibility for the Scholarship is final, and there is no right of appeal should the student be unsuccessful in securing the scholarship, or has the scholarship withdrawn.
